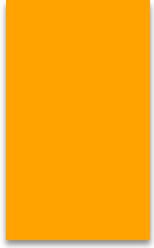






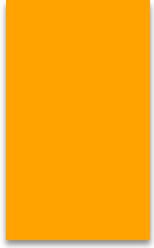
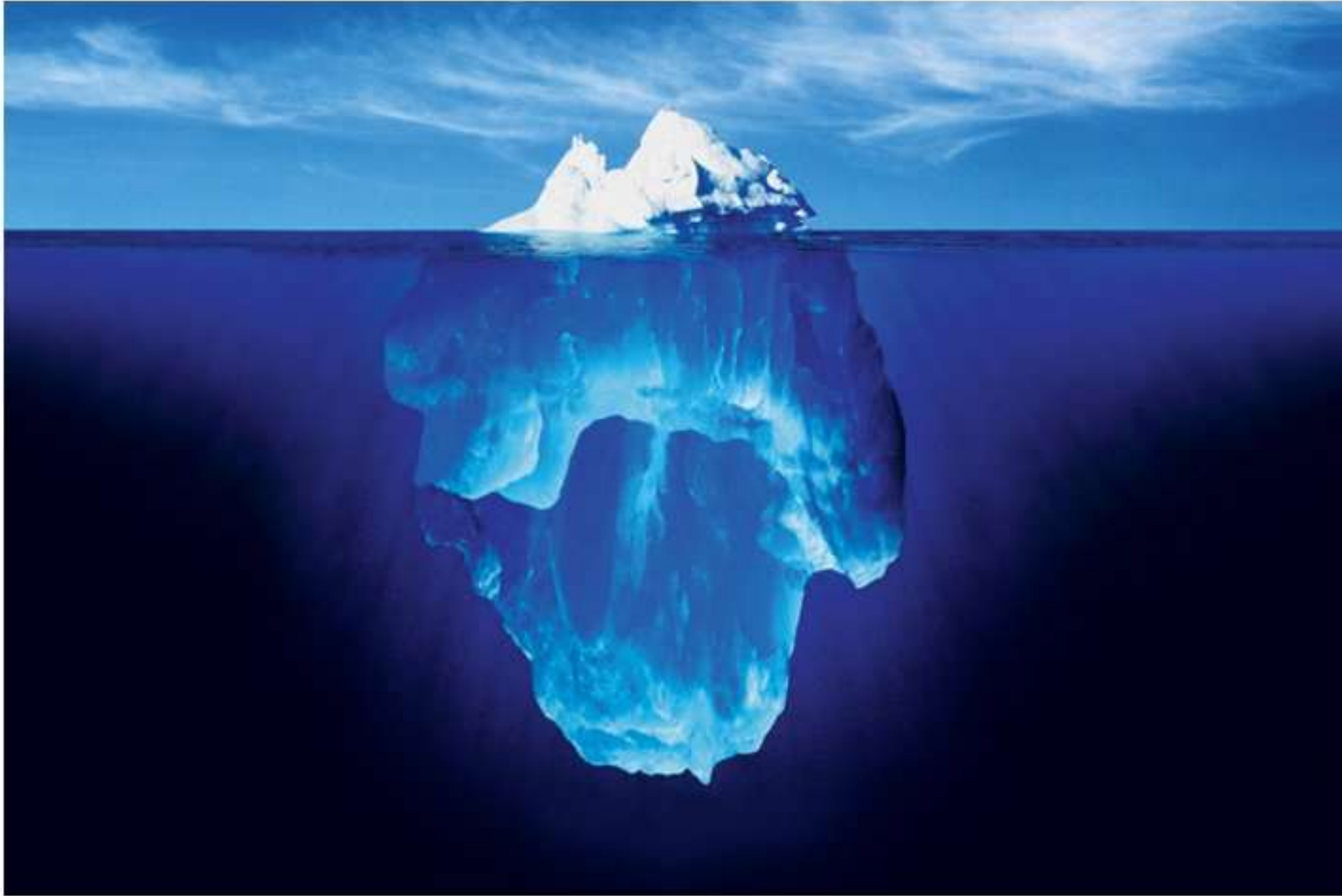




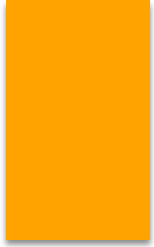


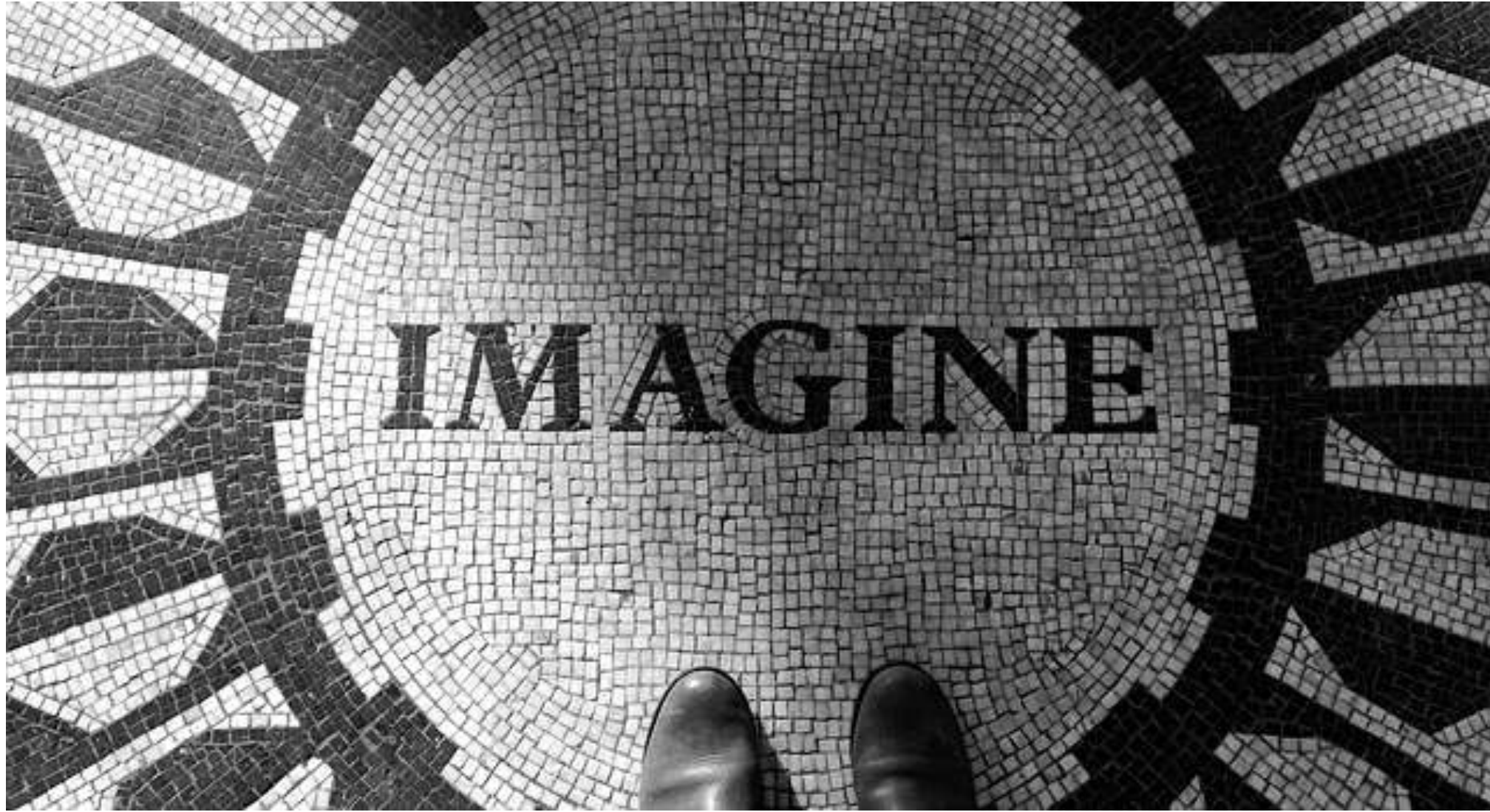














## Recommendation:
